

WHERE TO USE

Final finishing treatments and routine maintenance of wooden floors treated with **Ultracoat Oil**. Repairing small scratches made during laying operations on new wooden floors.

TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Ultracoat Oil Care is a solvent-free, natural drying oil in water dispersion for final finishing treatments and routine maintenance of wooden floors.

Ultracoat Oil Care used for routine maintenance operations helps maintain the original beauty of wooden floors as when they were originally laid.

Ultracoat Oil Care leaves the floor with a matt finish.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Do not use Ultracoat Oil Care at temperatures lower than +10°C.
- Do not apply on external surfaces.
- Use only clean containers and tools.
- Environmental conditions and residual humidity in the wood when it is laid must conform to current norms and standards.
- Do not put leftover quantities of the product back into its original container.

 Do not use Ultracoat Oil Care for maintenance on wooden floors treated with oil which have a matt or grey appearance. In such cases, apply a coat of Ultracoat Oil beforehand.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE Preparation of the substrate

Final treatment of wooden floors after applying **Ultracoat Oil**.

Wooden surfaces treated prior to application with **Ultracoat Oil** must be clean, dry and free of dust.

Routine maintenance of wooden floors treated with oil

Wooden surfaces treated with oil must be clean, dry and free of dust.

Uneven or rough areas on the surface may be removed by passing over with a rotating head fitted with a black **Ultracoat Pad** or by light sanding. In such cases, if the whole of the surface is not covered with a priming coat of **Ultracoat Oil**, apply another coat of the product with an **Ultracoat Roller Plus** or an **Ultracoat Steel Spatula**. Within 60 minutes of spreading on the product remove excess oil with a cotton rag with the aid of a rotating head fitted with a white **Ultracoat Pad**.

Application

16 hours after spreading on **Ultracoat Oil** (in those cases where it has been applied) pass over the surface of the wood with a brush fitted with a black **Ultracoat Pad**. Then apply two coats of **Ultracoat Oil Care** 30 minutes apart using a wax spreader or

rotating head fitted with a white **Ultracoat Pad** and a cotton rag.

Cleaning

Tools and residues of **Ultracoat Oil Care** may be cleaned with water while the product is still fresh.

24 months in its original, sealed packaging in a dry place.

To avoid the risks of fires, all contamined materials should be stored in metal containers with tight-fitting self-closing lids. Contamined materials should be stored outside.
