MAINTENANCE

Ultracoat Polish Remover is a concentrated de-waxing solution developed specifically for removing Ultracoat Clean Polish / Ultracoat Clean WPM from finished wooden floors. It may also be used to remove small surface defects from floors finished with water-based varnishes of the Ultracoat line.

- Suitable for both residential and commercial environments.
- Specific product for removing Ultracoat Clean Polish / Ultracoat Clean WPM and similar products.
- Easy to use.
- Removing old layers of Ultracoat Clean Polish / Ultracoat Clean WPM and similar products.

Before applying the product, the surfaces to be treated must be thoroughly cleaned to remove all traces of dirt, dust, grease, etc.

Dilute 250 ml of Ultracoat Polish Remover in 10 litres of warm water (+25°C). Apply the diluted solution evenly on the surface to be treated with a clean, soft cloth or with a floor scrubber for larger surfaces. Remove the solution from the treated surface with clean water.

· Larger surfaces with old, hardened layers of Ultracoat Clean Polish / Ultracoat Clean WPM.

Before applying the product, the surfaces to be treated

must be thoroughly cleaned to remove all traces of dirt, dust, grease, etc.

Dilute 250 ml of Ultracoat Polish Remover in 10 litres of warm water (+25°C). Apply the diluted solution evenly on the surface to be treated with a single-head rotary brush fitted with a red Ultracoat Pad. Remove all traces of dirt with a floor scrubber or a damp cloth. Then thoroughly clean the floor with clean water. The quantity of water required for cleaning must be reduced to the minimum possible.

Preparing surfaces before removing small surface defects

Dilute 75 ml of Ultracoat Polish Remover in 10 litres of warm water (+25°C). Apply the diluted solution and after a few minutes dry the surface with a clean cloth.

- It is very important that all traces of Ultracoat Polish Remover are completely eliminated before spreading on a new coat of Ultracoat Clean Polish / Ultracoat Clean WPM.
- Floors treated with Ultracoat Polish Remover or similar products must be sanded down to bare wood before being re-varnished.

Ultracoat Polish Remover is irritant to the eyes. Avoid contact with the eyes.
